# About the School District, continued. . .

## Referenda

**2007** - a referendum was approved giving the District permission to levy a tax for three budget years to exceed the revenue limit by \$800,000 for two years and \$875,000 for one year.

**2010** - a referendum extended the permission to exceed the revenue limit for two additional years in the amount of \$875,000.

**2012** - a referendum was approved not to exceed \$1,000,000 for building, remodeling and improvement projects, and technology upgrades. It also approved extending the permission to exceed the revenue limit for two additional years in the amount of \$925,000.

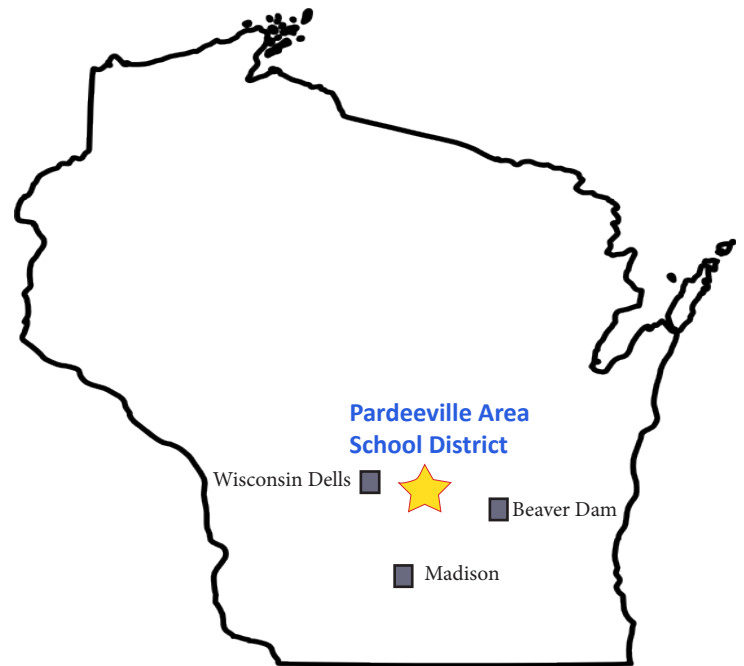
**2014** - a referendum was approved to exceed the revenue limit by \$905,000 for the 2014-2015 school year, \$885,000 for the 2015-2016 school year, and by \$850,000 for the 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 school years. The referendum also approved permission to borrow not to exceed \$800,000 for capital improvement projects at District buildings and sites.

**2017** - a referendum was approved to borrow \$11,935,000 to fund a school building and improvement program consisting of constructing additions for an auditorium, a secure High School entrance, offices, and other safety and security improvements, renovating and remodeling the existing facilities for additional classroom/academic space, a community-accessible weight room/fitness center, and relocating the library; completing related parking and site work; and related furnishings, fixtures, and equipment. The referendum also approved exceeding the revenue limit by \$130,000 beginning with the 2018-2019 school year for recurring purposes consisting of operating expenses associated with building and auditorium additions, and by an additional \$850,000 for the 2018-2019 school year through the 2021-2022 school year for non-recurring purposes.

The District will need to go to referendum to extend the revenue control in April of 2022.



## About the Pardeeville Community



With a population of about 2,110 people, the Village of Pardeeville offers a small-town atmosphere, but is only 10 miles from Portage and 35 miles from Madison. The Village of Wyocena population is about 758.

### Candidate Profile

The Pardeeville Area School District is an academically successful and fiscally responsible rural district located in south central Wisconsin, 30 miles north of Madison. The district's strengths begin with the commitment of the staff to collaboratively focus on the needs of all children - academic, physical, emotional and social - while maintaining high expectations for all. On the last published Department of Public Instruction Report Cards (2018-19), all schools and the District rated Exceeds Expectations.

An enrollment of 825 students allows for a personal approach to working with students and their families that has led to a culture of community support for the district schools. Besides passing an operating referendum in 2017 in which over 60% of the voters chose to support the schools, the community also approved construction of an auditorium, a secure High School entrance, new offices, renovation and remodeling of existing facilities for additional classroom/academic space, a community fitness center, and relocating the library. In addition, the community's Pardeeville Bulldog Support Foundation was involved in the creation of the Pardeeville Athletic Complex and was a financial supporter of the new Lenz Auditorium. The geographical location and academic, athletic and fine arts offerings contribute to a quality of life that makes Pardeeville a prime place to raise a family.

The leader of this district needs to be civic-minded, the face of the school community, well-versed in school finance, a builder of school district culture, an excellent communicator, have strong interpersonal skills and have the leadership capabilities to move the district forward along a pathway of continuous improvement.
