Highlights

The School District of Mondovi has been committed to delivering high-quality educational opportunities to generations of students since the original school was built in 1937. The focus within our schools is to provide an educational environment that is friendly, supportive, and allows our students to learn and be successful. We are proud of our many accomplishments including, but not limited to, recent State Qualifiers in Destination Imagination, Equestrian, Dance, FBLA, FCCLA, Forensics, Track & Field, Wrestling, and Spelling Bee.

Construction/Renovation

School District taxpayers approved an \$18 million dollar referendum in the fall of 2018. The main referendum project construction is completed. With the approval of that referendum, we were able to upgrade STEM classrooms, modernize current classrooms, upgrade security systems, create safe and secure entrances, make classroom security upgrades, build a new loading dock and a new commons area, and construct a new bus path. With the leftover funds, work is scheduled to begin spring 2021 on replacement of tennis courts, construction of a new outdoor concession stand with restrooms, and replacement of the stadium lights.

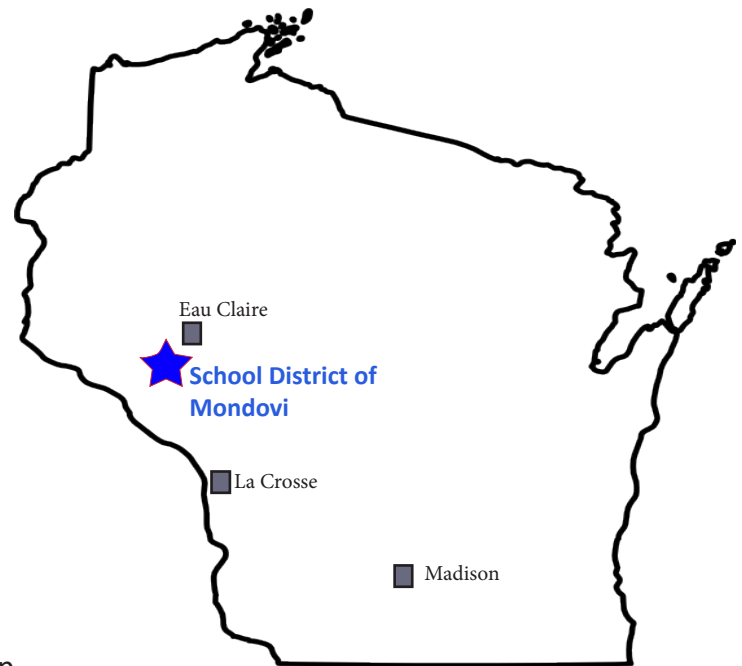

About the Mondovi Community

The School District of Mondovi covers approximately 204 square miles and includes the City of Mondovi and all or portions of the following townships: Canton, Modena, Mondovi, and Naples in Buffalo County; Brunswick, Drammen, and Pleasant Valley in Eau Claire County; Albany in Pepin County; and Rock Creek in Dunn County.



City Hall Museum - This Museum is a “must see” stop for anyone interested in Mondovi Area History. The Museum is staffed by helpful historical society volunteers. Books, pictures, journals, souvenirs - if it has to do with Mondovi Area History ~ it is probably here.

Mondovi Rural Life & Country Schoolhouse Museums - Three museum buildings plus an authentic cabin offer a delightful glimpse into our local rural history. These local history gems are located in Mondovi’s “Tourist Park”. Mondovi Area Historical Society members staff these Museums.

Buffalo County Fair - The Buffalo County Fairgrounds are located in Mondovi, and the annual fair takes place each year in August. The fair features a carnival, rides, food and drink stands, displays, judging, contests, music, entertainment and more. Farmers Markets - Several area vendors provide Farmer’s Market type roadside markets for farm fresh produce and flowers during the spring, summer and fall. A local Farmer’s Market takes place on Tuesdays and Saturdays during the growing season at the Roger Marten Community Center parking area.

Garden Club - If you visit Mondovi during the growing season it is hard to miss the lovely landscaping and flower plantings in public areas. The local garden club plans, provides, and maintains these beautiful areas. The club also holds an annual flower show during the Friendship Days Celebration near the 4th of July.

Ice Fishing Contest - A big draw for winter fun is the annual Ice Fishing Contest held on Mirror Lake in February. Prizes, games, food, beverage, and entertainment give residents and visitors a reason to look forward to winter. The event is organized by the Mondovi Conservation Club.

Mondovi Friendship Days Parade - Join the City of Mondovi at the Grand Parade on July 4th. There will be a kiddie parade followed by the Grand Parade, a talent show in the afternoon, and fireworks at dusk.

Shamrock Shuffle - This event in March is hosted by the Mondovi Business Association. You’ll find business specials, games, raffles, and even green beer. Proceeds go to fund improvements in our community.

Rodeo - The Little Britches Rodeo is held in late spring and highlights talented individuals. The active Midnight Riders (www.mriders.com) equine club organizes the event and several others each year.

Candidate Profile

Mondovi is a city of 2,700 located on the Buffalo River, 25 miles south of Eau Claire. The Mondovi School District is unique in that it educates all PreK-12 students in one building, except for the students that attend Anthony Acres Charter School. The district has a student population of approximately 900.

The Mondovi Area School community prides itself in having a district with a caring and effective staff, a variety of coursework and activities for students, a supportive community, and success in the classroom; ranking academic achievement as the highest strength of the district in a recent survey. The board of education prides itself in the accomplishments above while being fiscally responsible.

Like many Wisconsin school districts in these uncertain financial times, the School District of Mondovi is concerned about attracting and retaining quality staff in a time of steady to slowly declining enrollment. Although slowly declining, the student population continues to require a variety of supports to serve their diverse needs.

The new superintendent has to be able to cultivate a culture of caring and understanding through the demonstration of good interpersonal and communication skills. The fiscal needs, and the soon-to-be-retiring operating referendum, will need to be addressed as the new superintendent communicates the District's story to the citizens of Mondovi and the nine townships that make up the school district. The new leader needs to be civic-minded, the face of the school community, visible to the students, staff, parents, and the community, and be a proven collaborative leader. It is also important that the new superintendent has a background/working knowledge of school finance and instructional services, as they lead the district forward toward a vision of continuous improvement.
