The successful candidate is expected to understand the characteristics of urban and rural schools and establish strong working relationships with the member school districts, Agency staff, and other consumers of CESA services. The successful candidate will serve as the primary advisor to the Board of Control. In addition, the successful candidate should possess and exhibit skills and experiences in the following areas:

Leadership – Practice a leadership style that builds a culture of collaboration and teamwork and allows employees to maximize their skills and capabilities while holding them accountable for their performance. Demonstrate strong planning skills to ensure that the Agency and its member school districts are prepared for change and equipped for the future. Provide strong leadership and support to the Board of Control, the Professional Advisory Committee, and Agency staff.

Financial - Possess a solid understanding of school finance, business, and marketing practices while practicing innovative thinking in terms of potential revenue sources. Provide oversight to the fiscal operations of the Agency. Understand the underlying financial circumstances facing member school districts and adjust program offerings and costs accordingly to maintain participation levels and ensuring member satisfaction.

Communication/Interpersonal Skills - Demonstrate a sincere desire to listen to the needs and issues expressed by CESA 7 staff members and member school districts. Write and speak with clarity when outlining and promoting programs and services to member schools. Demonstrate strong working relationships with member school districts using multiple means of delivery to ensure information is received and feedback is measurable. Exhibit an interest to build effective connections with legislators, higher education, businesses, and community leaders to advance issues important to the Agency and public education.

Continuous Improvement – Demonstrate a commitment to continuous professional development for all Agency personnel using varied means to identify future trends and issues pertinent to the development and advancement of programs and services to member school districts. Participate in local, regional, state, and national organizations to create networks from which data and knowledge can be gathered to strengthen the Agency's ability to respond to consumers of CESA 7 services.

Cooperative Educational Service Agencies — better known as CESAs — help school districts share staff, services and purchasing, and provide a link between local districts and the state. All services provided are determined by participating member school districts. Special education for disabled students is the service CESAs most commonly provide schools.

The organization of school districts in Wisconsin is such that the legislature recognizes the need for a service unit between the school district and the State Superintendent. The Cooperative Educational Service Agencies may provide leadership and coordination of services for school districts, including such programs as curriculum development assistance; school district management development; coordination of vocational education; and exceptional education, research, special student classes, human growth and development, data collection processing and dissemination, and in-service programs.

CESA 7 is located in Brown County. There are two building locations; the Main Campus is in Green Bay, and the south Campus (Head Start) is in Manitowoc.
