The Barneveld School District seeks a committed and thoughtful leader who inspires trust and confidence, is skilled in written and verbal communications, and builds positive relationships in the school and the community. The successful candidate will demonstrate approachability, integrity, and a willingness to take on tasks wherever needed in the building.

As the leader of the Barneveld School District, the next superintendent must be a strategic thinker, a motivational manager, and an advocate for the best possible educational opportunities to meet the needs of the students. The next superintendent will need to demonstrate a strong ability in each of the following areas:

People Skills: Able to listen and work with staff, students, board of education, and community; be approachable; have difficult conversations with individuals, when necessary; hold people accountable; yet consistently treat people with dignity. Be highly visible in the school and get to know staff and students on a one-to-one basis.

Leadership: Is both a collaborative leader and a transformational leader who inspires students and staff to give their greatest effort. Is characterized as strategic, proactive, and thoughtful rather than reactionary, consistently following through on commitments and doing things with a purpose in mind. Demonstrates the ability to make decisions in a timely manner. Does not micro-manage but observes and provides constructive feedback. Experience in either a district-level administrative position or as a building principal are acceptable and desired.

Financial Skills: Must be knowledgeable about school finances, have business acumen to manage the district's financial resources, and set financial and instructional priorities. The superintendent is the district's chief financial officer.

Communications: Can explain school district instructional programs and financial issues to community members in a clear and consistent fashion through various media, and promote and market the district to attract and retain students.

Vision: Works with the principal, staff, and community to develop and articulate a clear vision for where the school needs to go and a plan for how to get there.

The Barneveld School District serves the Village of Barneveld and Brigham Township. The district houses its K-12 students in one building; K4 is housed in the lower level of the public library.

The district completed an extensive building addition in May of 2019. The addition included an entire new elementary wing; tech ed, band, and vocal music rooms; a new library, art room and weight room; and a new 1,000 capacity gym as well as new office space. The referendum for the 2019 addition passed with 85% voter approval. Currently there is no plan for another referendum.

In addition to normal sports programs for high and middle school girls and boys, recently a Trap Shooting Club was started and is popular with students of all ages. Barneveld actively participates in the Wisconsin High School Forensic Association in both high school theatre and speech. We are consistently recognized as a top-performing school in both the one-act play festival and forensics, having received a number of Critic's Choice awards and a couple of Excellence in Speech awards. We often have up to 1/3 of the high school involved in our events. We perform in the play festival every other year and produce a full-length play the opposite year. We also have high school students participate in the Wisconsin Model United Nations.

Barneveld is a village in Iowa County, Wisconsin, United States. Barneveld is a wonderful community nestled in the rolling hills of southwest Wisconsin. It is an easy 30-minute drive from Madison, WI.
