About the School District

The Blair-Taylor School District is located in Trempealeau County in Wisconsin - 43 miles north of La Crosse, 53 miles south of Eau Claire, and 151 miles northwest of Madison. The district serves 630 students in three schools in one building: PK-5 elementary school, 6-8 middle school, and 9-12 high school. The Blair and Taylor school districts consolidated in the 1989-90 school year when the district became the Blair-Taylor Wildcats.

The district passed a referendum in fall 2020. Since then, improvements to the school have been made on schedule. The life skills classroom, 6th grade classrooms, and the business education classroom have been improved. The multipurpose baseball field was enhanced with a synthetic "sports turf." The district also built a highly anticipated childcare center.

Blair-Taylor students have the opportunity to become involved in the middle and high school Quiz Bowl, Letterman's Club, Student Council, SADD, National Honor Society, Spanish Club, yearbook, forensics, drama, FFA, FBLA, FCCLA, Odyssey of the Mind, elementary robotics, football, volleyball, cross-country, boys and girls basketball, wrestling, track, softball, and baseball.

The district awards a Student of the Month for the student's positive influence on the Blair-Taylor student body through exemplary qualities of character, citizenship, service, and leadership. The award is for living the Wildcat Way: Be honest, be respectful, be responsible, and be safe.

Community Celebrations & Gathering Places

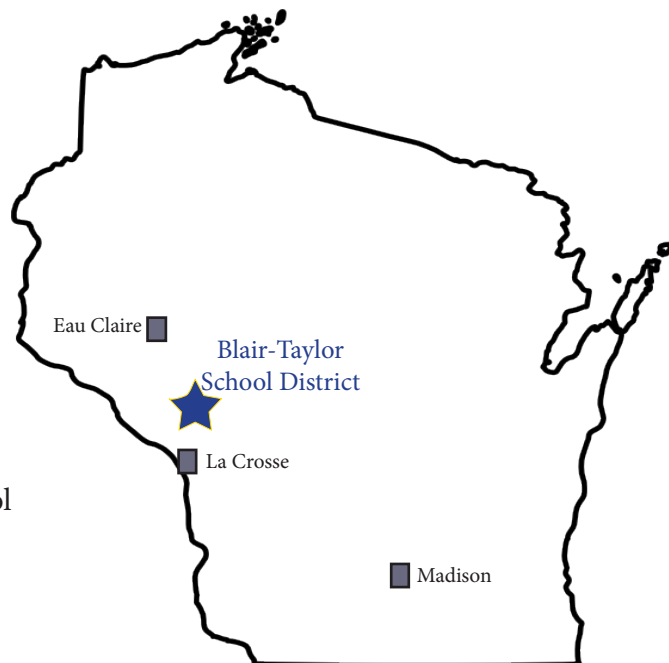
- July 3rd celebration in Blair
