The district boundaries incorporate Balsam Lake, Centuria, and Milltown residents, as well as the Round Lake Native American Community, covering over 140 square miles.

Successful Student Athlete Programs

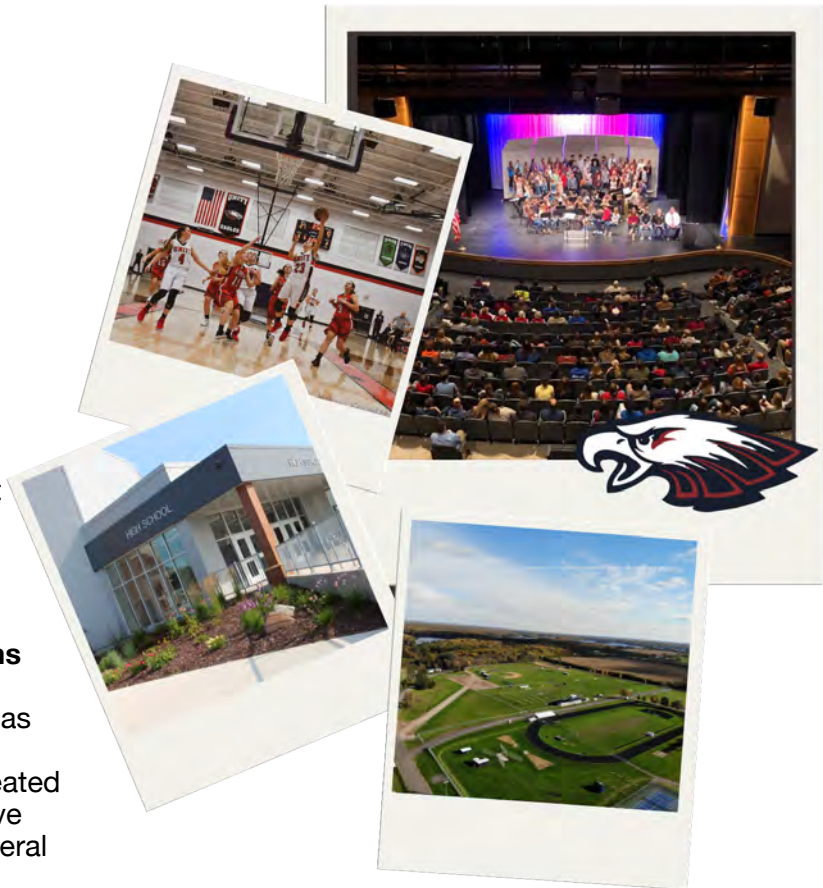

From conference and regional championships to state qualified athletes, Unity has a lot to be proud of!

Early Learning Means Early Success

- Unity School District offers the area’s first all-day, everyday four-year old kindergarten (Pre-K) program, paired with an exceptional Early Childhood program. A newly constructed child care center (LEAP - Little Eagles at Play) offers an environment of learning from 6 weeks to 4 years old.
- Unity’s unwavering commitment to early learning programming helps to benefit students early. From six weeks old through the early grades of the elementary school, Unity students and families have many opportunities to engage positively in school.

Wellness Opportunities

Unity School District is dedicated to providing comprehensive mental health supports for its students and employees. The District is an educational leader, a partner with local therapy providers and the county for a focused mental health program. Unity offers the area’s only in-school mental health therapy clinic for students. In addition to mental health the district is focused on student and staff wellness through the introduction of life-long activities such as cross-country skiing, snow shoeing, mountain biking, and kayaking, as well as a Community Fitness Center.

Exemplary Performing Arts

Unity has a strong tradition of excellence in performing arts programs. The music program offers traditional band and choir, as well as jazz and individual performance opportunities. Unity has several state award winning student musicians every year. Additionally, there are high school and middle school theater performances annually, with all events and performances being held in our state-of-the-art Performing Arts Center.

Summer School

Unity School District has the most successful summer school program in the area. Unity students are able to take creative classes that are focused on their interests where learning is also fun! The summer school program reinforces what they have learned through the year, but also provides enrichment opportunities where students are only limited by their imagination. In recent years, the Unity Summer School Program has been able to incorporate additional enrichment courses, filling our buildings with students nearly each week in the summer months, and through most of the day!

Diploma Plus Program Creates Opportunities

The Unity School District is determined to have each high school graduate leave high school with their HS diploma and additional qualifications which may include college credit, technical college coursework, or certification. Unity's unique approach to high school education emphasizes post-high school opportunities, providing a jump start to college preparation and potentially reducing college costs to families. In addition to offering the area's only Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA) and CDL programs and a multitude of Advanced Placement (AP) courses, the Early College Credit Program and the Start College Now program gives Unity students the potential to obtain up to 18 college credits during their high school years for free.

These programs serve as amazing resources for an increasing number of students each year. Since 2020, over 100 Unity students have taken a collective variety of 85 college courses and earned an astounding 327 college credits, saving Unity High School students more than \$65,000 in college costs in the last two years.
