The School District of Sevastopol is located in Door County, 50 miles NE of Green Bay. According to U.S. News and World Report, Sevastopol High School is ranked the #38 best high school in Wisconsin! Furthermore, it has a national rank of 1,487.

A \$25.1 million building referendum in 2018 demolished the original building, renovated existing spaces and financed a new addition. Athletic fields/facilities were upgraded in 2022. A non-recurring operating cost referendum for \$2.0 million annually expires in 2024-25. A November 2024 operating cost referendum will probably be on the ballot.

Sevastopol School District is ideally located in central Door County close to the amenities to the south in the county's urban core of Sturgeon Bay, but also near to all that the tranquil northern Door area has to offer. It serves the children of the Town of Sevastopol, Town of Egg Harbor, Town of Jacksonsport and Town of Sturgeon Bay.

The school's 150,000 square foot buildings hold all 4k-12th grades on one campus and is located on a beautiful 50-acre site right off of Highway 57, just seven miles north of Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin. Included on the site are athletic fields, a school forest, community walking trails, large playground areas and a new addition built in 2021. This new addition comprises the 4k-5th grade classes, a 19,000 sq foot greenhouse, middle and high school science wing, and an industrial arts wing including a Fab Lab and art wing. In addition, the school has a 67-acre Eco Lab containing three bodies of water and walking trails. Next door to the school is the Sevastopol Town Hall with multiple baseball/softball fields, outdoor basketball courts and a pickleball court.

Door County, being an incredible place to live, is humbled to be named one of the 10 Best Small Towns in America by Fodor's. In addition to all the outdoor offerings, there are hundreds of non-chain shops, restaurants, good, quality jobs, safe communities and a thriving business climate. With all the county has to offer, being surrounded by over 300 miles of shoreline is just the cherry on top to easily reimagine your life in Door County.

Central Door provides a wide range of shopping, leisure activities, entertainment and culture. Visit The Hill Raceway and the Door County Fair. Hike in the Potawatomi State Park just outside of town. Go boating and kayaking or shipwreck diving on the bay. Enjoy holiday festivals and parades.

The northern region is defined by shoreline, cherry farms and small-town living. Historic towns grew in between the major highway and shore on both sides of the peninsula.
