Thanks to the community's support, we're excited to move forward with designing and building a new Bayside Middle School and making critical improvements to Stormonth Elementary.



Groundbreaking for the new Bayside Middle School is expected in spring of 2023, with construction continuing through the summer of 2024. Renovations and improvements at Stormonth Elementary School will also take place over the same timeline.
